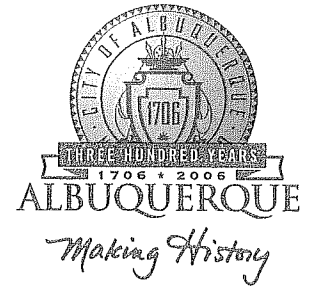

RE: Air Quality Authority-To-Construct Permit #0902-M3

Dear Mr. Silber:

The City of Albuquerque, Environmental Health Department, Air Quality Division (Division) is responsible for the review and issuance of Air Quality Permits for any source of air contaminants within Bernalillo County. The Division performs a technical review of each application submitted and rules it either complete or incomplete. Once an application is deemed complete, the Division is required to provide at least 45 (but no more than 60) days for public comment on each application. If sufficient comment is received regarding the completed application, the Division may elect to hold a public hearing.

The Division received an Air Quality Permit modification application from **American Cement Corporation** for improvements to the facility (such as replacing the current baghouses with high efficiency cartridge type dust collectors) so that it may operate continuously. The facility is located at 4702 Carlton St NW, in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The Division has performed an initial technical review of the application. On March 19, 2009 the Division conducted an evaluation and has ruled the application complete and has assigned this application Permit No. 0902-M3.

A copy of the public notice for Permit No. 0902-M3 that was issued in a locally circulated newspaper is included with this letter. The public notice period runs from Monday, March 23, 2009 through Thursday, May 7, 2009. If a hearing is judged appropriate, then the Division may take up to 180 days to issue the permit following the date upon which such application is deemed complete. If a public hearing is not scheduled, then the Division has 90 days to issue or deny a permit following the date upon which the application is deemed complete.

**Modification to Air Quality
Certificate of Registration
and Authority-to-Construct Permit #0902-M1
for
American Cement Corporation**

American Cement Corporation has submitted an authority-to-construct air quality permit application to the Air Quality Division (Division) of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department for a modification to their existing authority-to-construct permit #0902-M1. The modification is for improvements to the facility (such as replacing the current baghouses with high efficiency cartridge type dust collectors) so that it may operate continuously. The new cartridges substantially increase collection efficiency to 99.95%. This facility is located at the American Cement Terminal, 4702 Carlton St. NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico. The owner of this facility is American Cement Corporation, 1340 N. Riverside Drive, Espanola, NM 87532. This application file has been assigned Permit #0902-M3.

The maximum air pollution emissions to the atmosphere from this facility have been estimated to be:

POLLUTANT	pounds per hour (lbs/hr)	tons per year (tpy)
Total Suspended Particulate (TSP)	3.98	18.62
Particulate Matter <10 microns (PM10)	1.39	6.30
Particulate Matter <2.5 microns (PM2.5)	0.40	1.78

The Division expects to initiate formal action on this permit application by May 14, 2009. However, the final writing of the permit will be reserved pending receipt and analysis of any additional details or information developed during the public comment period. Interested persons may submit written comments or request a public hearing on Permit #0902-M3 to the Air Quality Division, Air Quality Services, P.O. Box 1293, Albuquerque, NM 87103. Comments will be accepted and considered if postmarked by May 7, 2009.
